The WDL was developed by a team at the Library of Congress with technical assistance provided by the Bibliotheca Alexandrina of Alexandria, Egypt. It functions in seven languages – Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Portuguese, Russian and Spanish – and includes content in more than forty languages.

The United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) had issued a policy brief on a Global Green New Deal. According to the announcement, the Global Green New Deal, "has three broad objectives. In the short term, it should make a major contribution to reviving the world economy, saving and creating jobs, and protecting vulnerable groups. In the medium term, it should promote sustainable and inclusive growth and the achievement of the MDGs, especially ending extreme poverty by 2025. Also in the medium term, it must reduce carbon dependency and ecosystem degradation – these are key risks along a path to a sustainable world economy."

The report discusses how observed and projected impacts of climate change have implications for the enjoyment of human rights and for the obligations of States under international human rights law. Chapter I is focused on the main features of climate change; Chapter II outlines implications of climate change for human rights; Chapter III relates the discussion of the impacts of climate change on human rights with relevant obligations under international human rights law; Chapter IV draws conclusions on the relationship between climate change and human rights.

The number of asylum seekers in the European Union increased in 2008 for the second year running, according to provisional statistics compiled by the UN refugee agency. The increase can partly be attributed to higher numbers of asylum seekers from Afghanistan, Somalia and other countries in conflict. Although the number of Iraqi asylum seekers declined by 28 percent in 2008, Iraqis continued to be the largest nationality seeking asylum in the EU.
