

🕏 HEALTH

- 11 hospitals partially functioning (5 in north & 6 south of Wadi Gaza). 26 hospitals are out of service.
- 6 field hospitals functional (4 in Rafah & 2 in Khan Younis).
- ~30% of primary health care facilities functional.
- >643,000 cases of acute respiratory infections (source: WHO).
- >346,000 cases of diarrhea, of which 31% (~106,000) are children
- under 5 (source: WHO).
- 23 Emergency Medical Teams (EMTs).
- 33% (8 out of 24) of UNRWA health centers are operational

NUTRITION

- 28 children died of malnutrition & dehydration (source: MoH Gaza). ~31% of children under the age of two in northern Gaza suffer from: •
- >50.000 children are estimated to be acutely malnourished at present.

EDUCATION

- 625,000 students with no access to education.
- >6,200 students and ~300 educational staff killed (source: MoE).
- ~90% of 563 school buildings directly hit, damaged, or possibly damaged.
- 59% (188) of school buildings used as IDP shelters have been directly hit or damaged.

SHELTER

- 1 square metre of average space per person in IDP shelters.
- 41% of shelters lack sufficient ventilation.
- . 57% of shelters affected by rain and water infiltration
- . 150-155 UNRWA installations shelter IDPs.

FOOD SECURITY

- **854K** people facing emergency levels of food insecurity (*IPC* >1 million children in need of mental health and psycho-social support.

WATER AND SANITATION

 - 66 Civil Defence staff killed while on duty (source: GMO).

- >60% of residential buildings (World Bank, as of Jan 2024).

MOVEMENT AND ACCESS

Between 1-19 April, 32 humanitarian aid missions to northern Gaza were facilitated by the Israeli authorities (including 21 related to food assistance), 14 were denied or impeded, and 8 were cancelled due to logistical constraints. Moreover, 104 aid missions to areas in southern Gaza that require coordination were facilitated by the Israel authorities, **13** were denied or impeded, and **10** were cancelled.

50% (5,004 out of 9,762) of patients who submitted requests for medical evacuation have been approved, of whom 83% (4,083) have been medically evacuated abroad (source: WHO).

🛼 INCOMING TRUCKLOADS The pre-crisis average per working day in 2023 was 500 truckloads, including fuel.
